

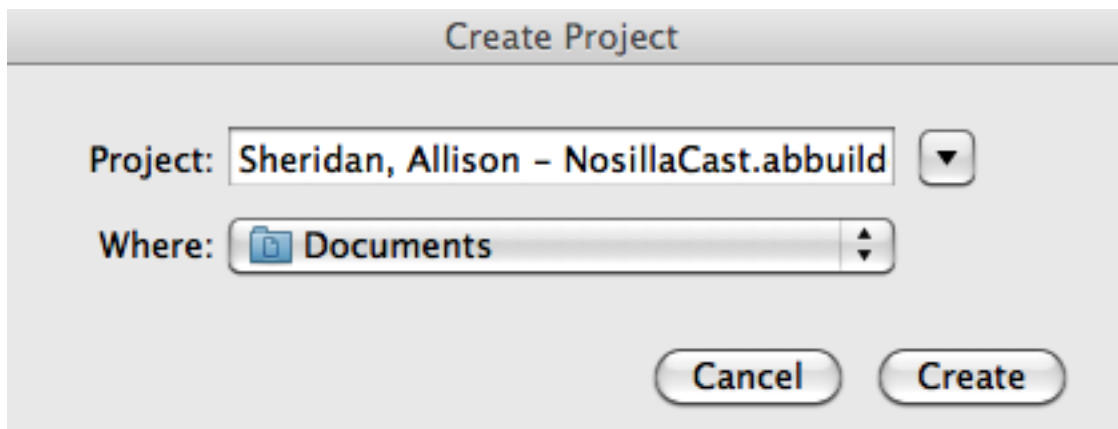
01 - Launch AudioBook Builder APP



02 - Click Create a New Project



03 - I like to name my projects with author's name, then book title because I have any number of books by same author



Of course, Allison is a PODCAST, not an AudioBook, but I'm being careful here not to violate any copyrights.

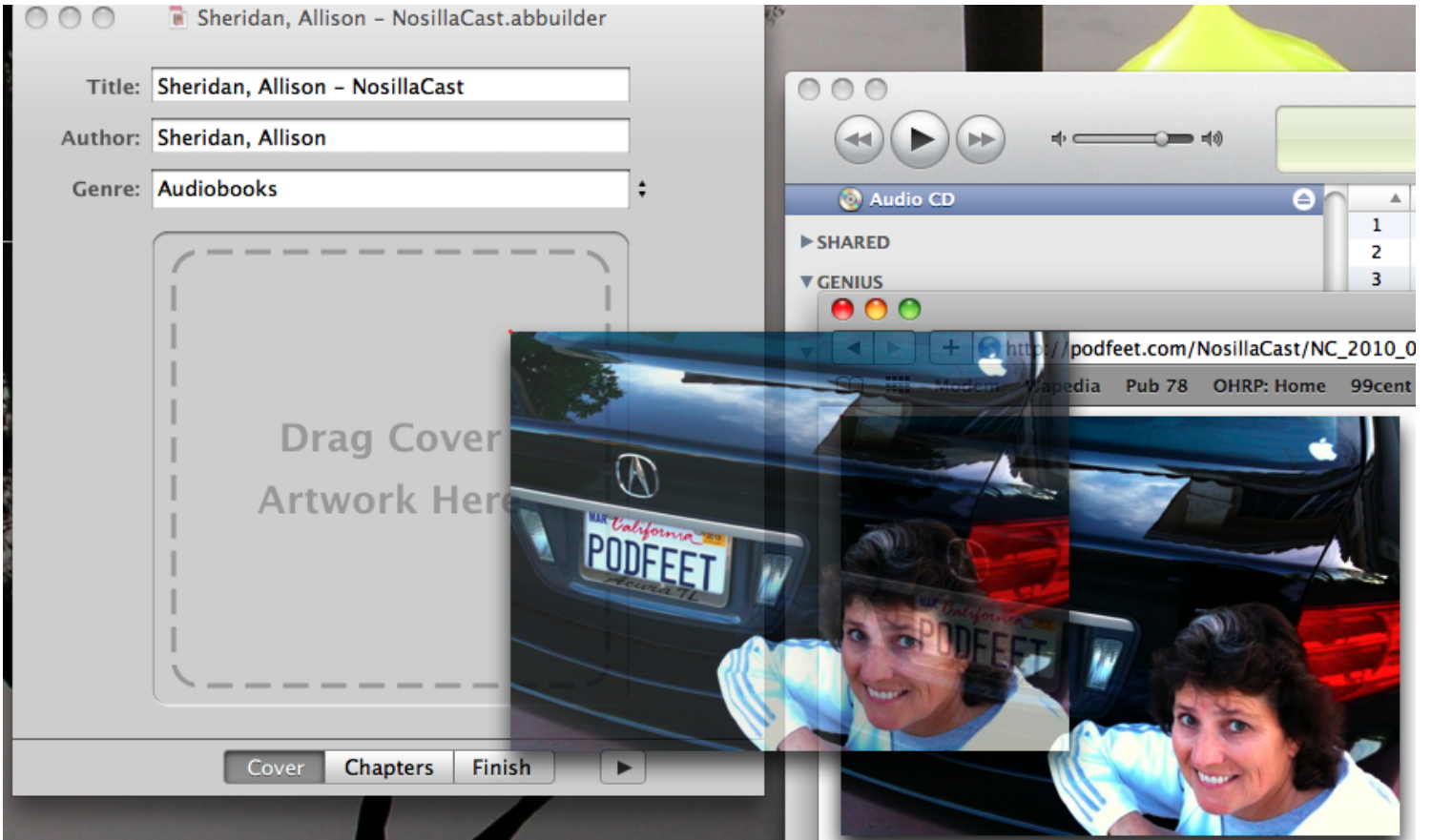

06 - Fill in Author Name, then CLICK "Chapters"

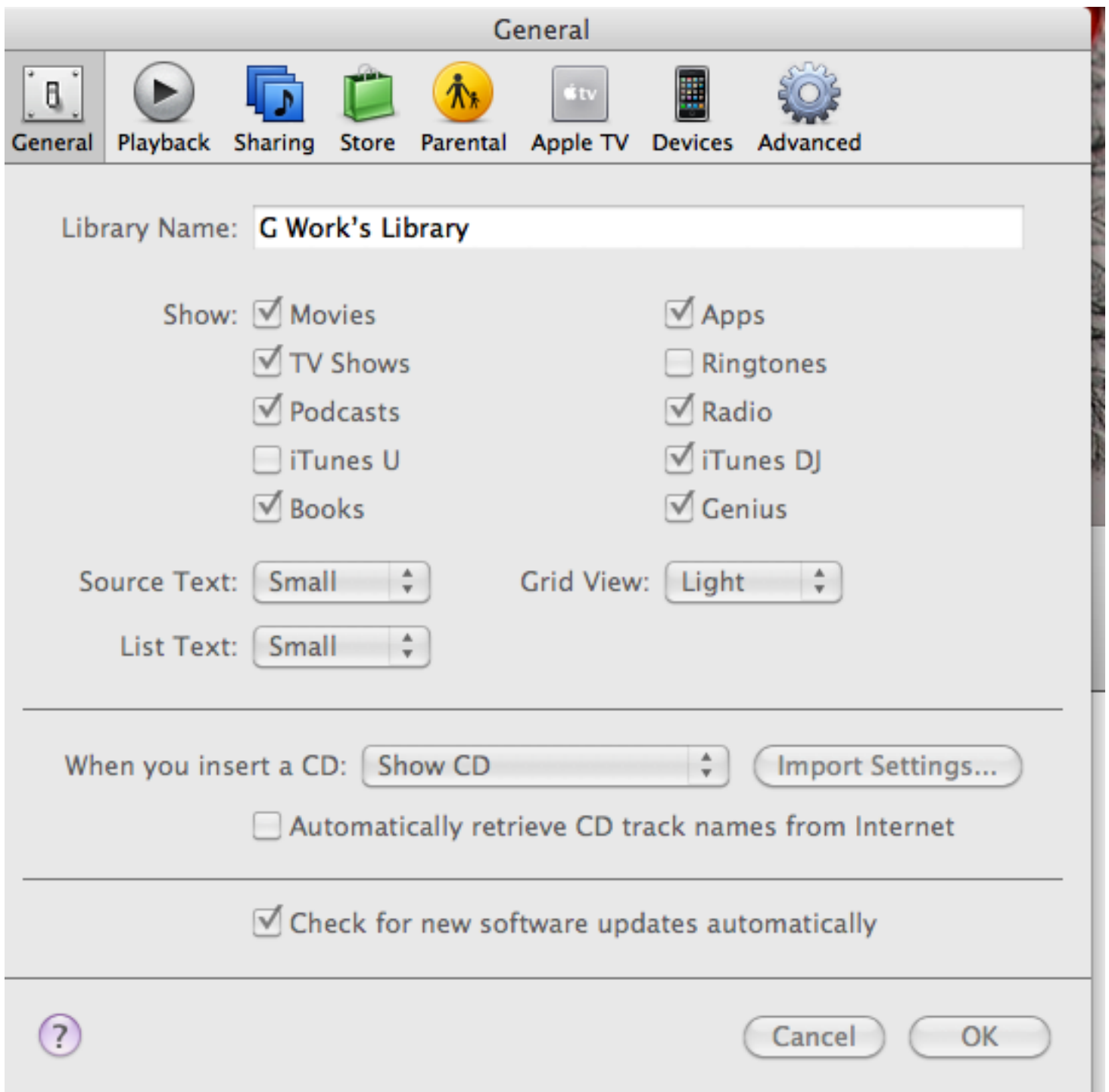

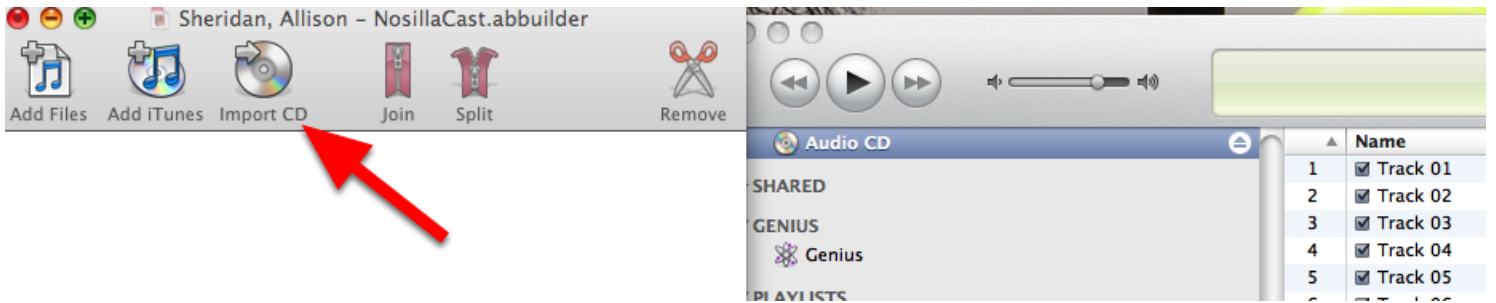

07 - Verify your iTunes preferences is set to show CDs, not import CDs



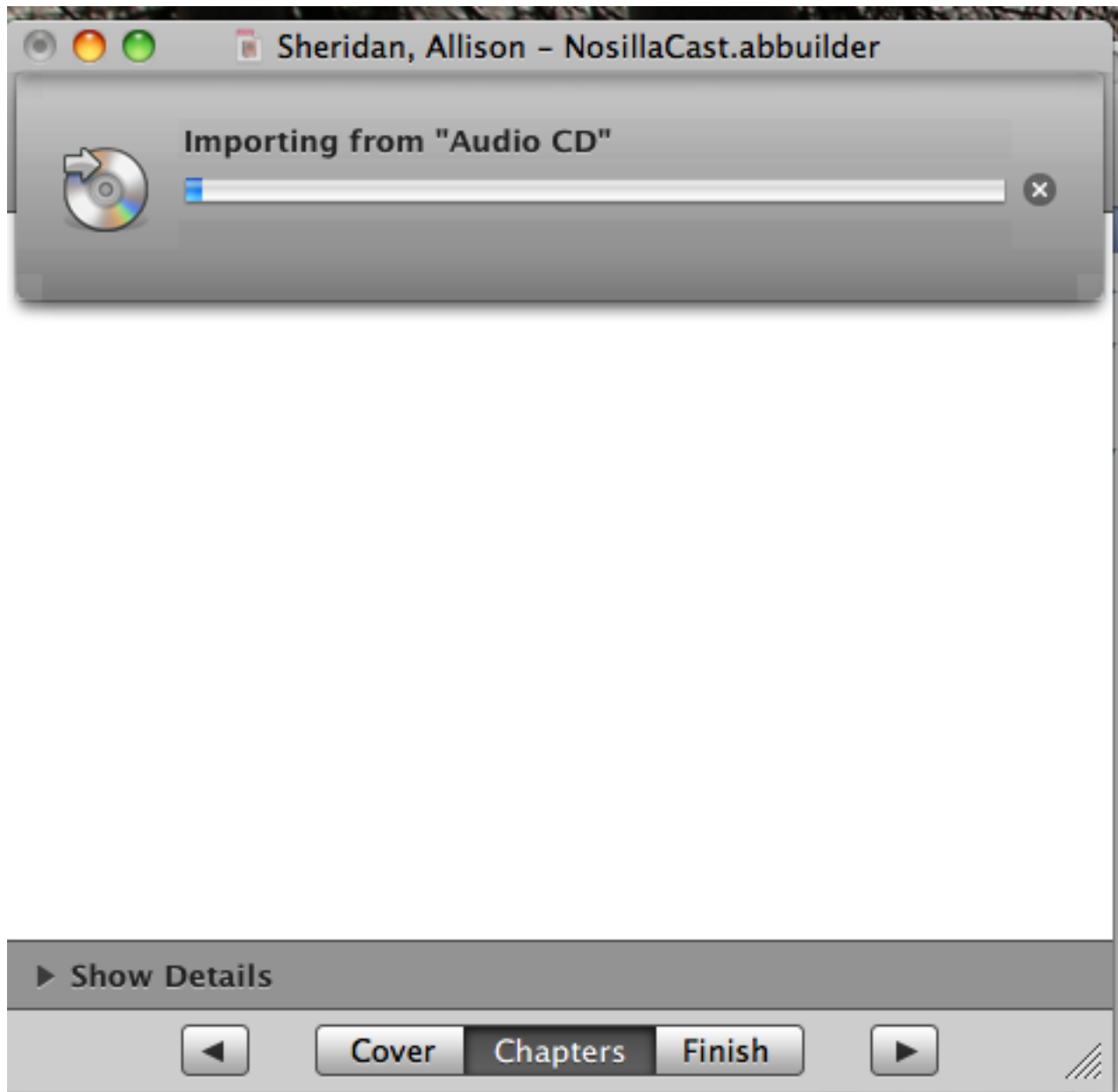
If iTunes is set to import, your MAC will import to iTunes AND to AudioBook Builder. V E R Y S L O O O W L Y

08 - Insert the CD. It will appear as an Audio CD in iTunes



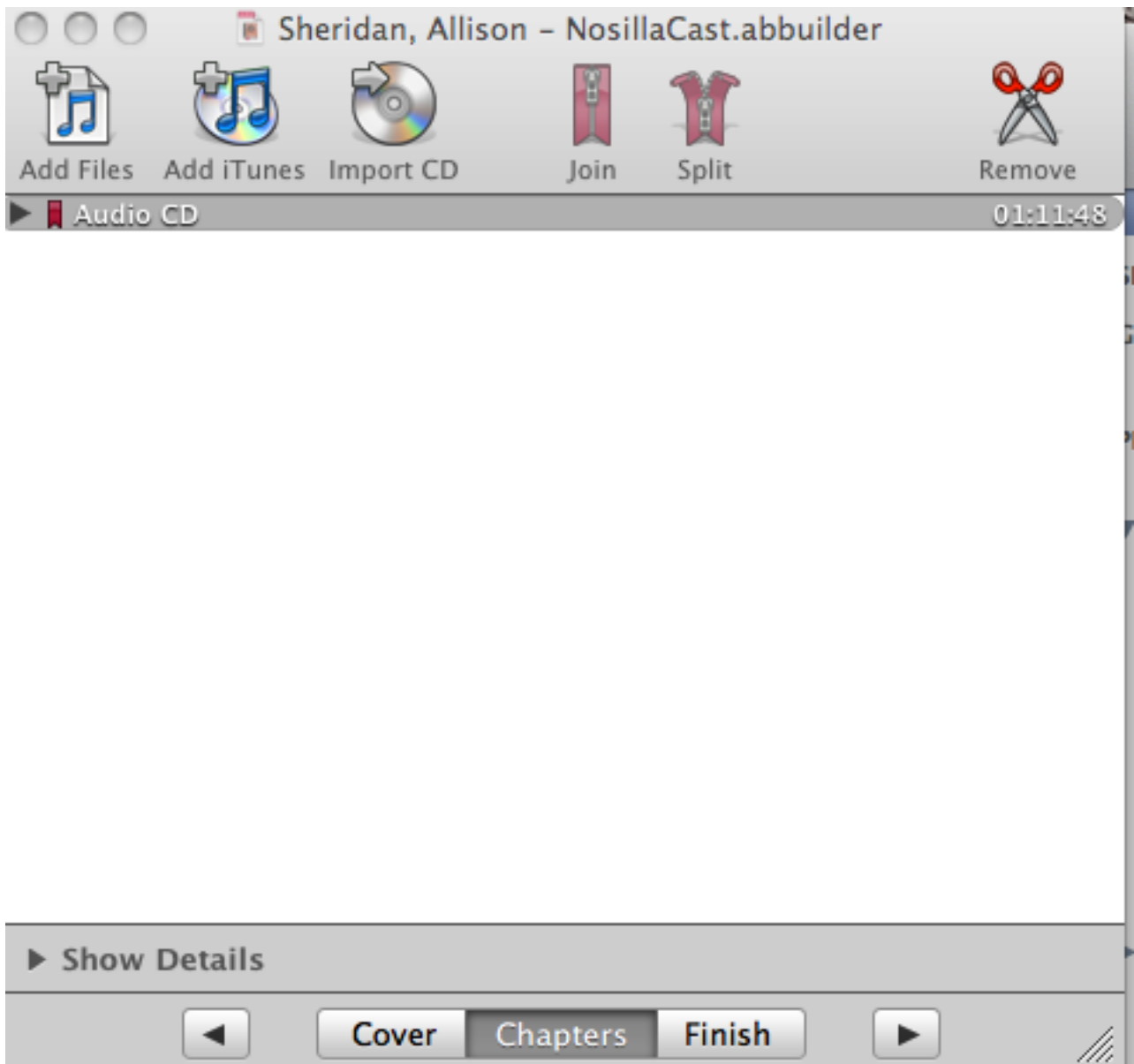
But NOT show up in AudioBook Builder. Ignore iTunes and Click IMPORT CD in ABB

09 - Accept or Set NORMAL in ABB, click import CD (see #08 above)

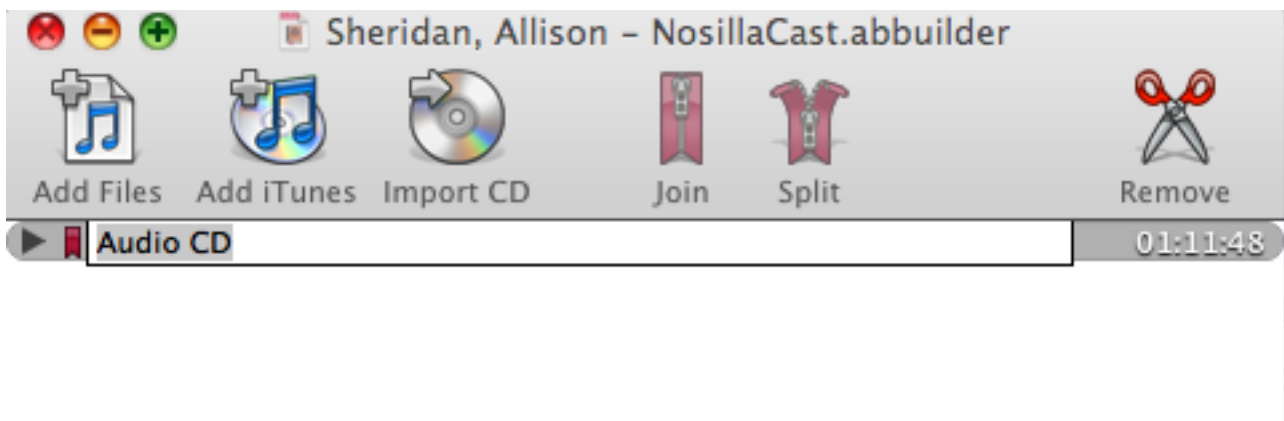


This will import the CD into ABB, but not into iTunes. Takes a while!

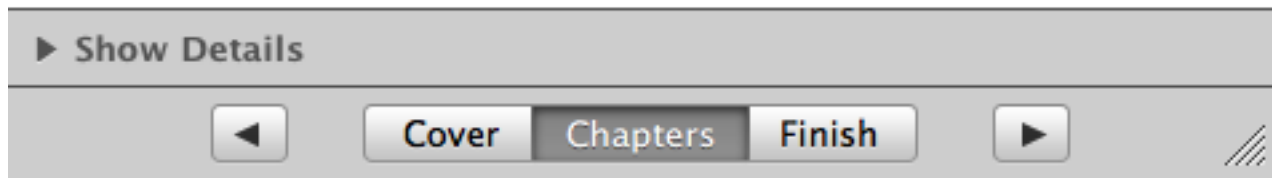
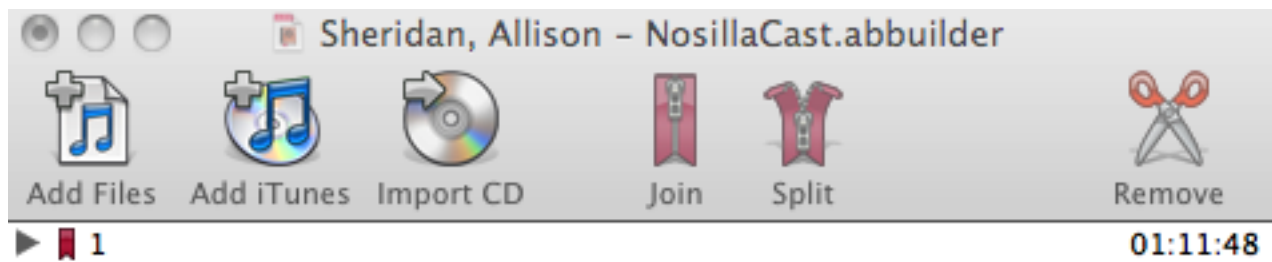
10 - ABB will Bingle at you to signal import is done. Note it has a RED Audio CD Line



11 - OPTIONAL - Click into the AUDIO CD name to Change to a Useful Chapter



12 - This is the first disk of 10, so I've named it 1

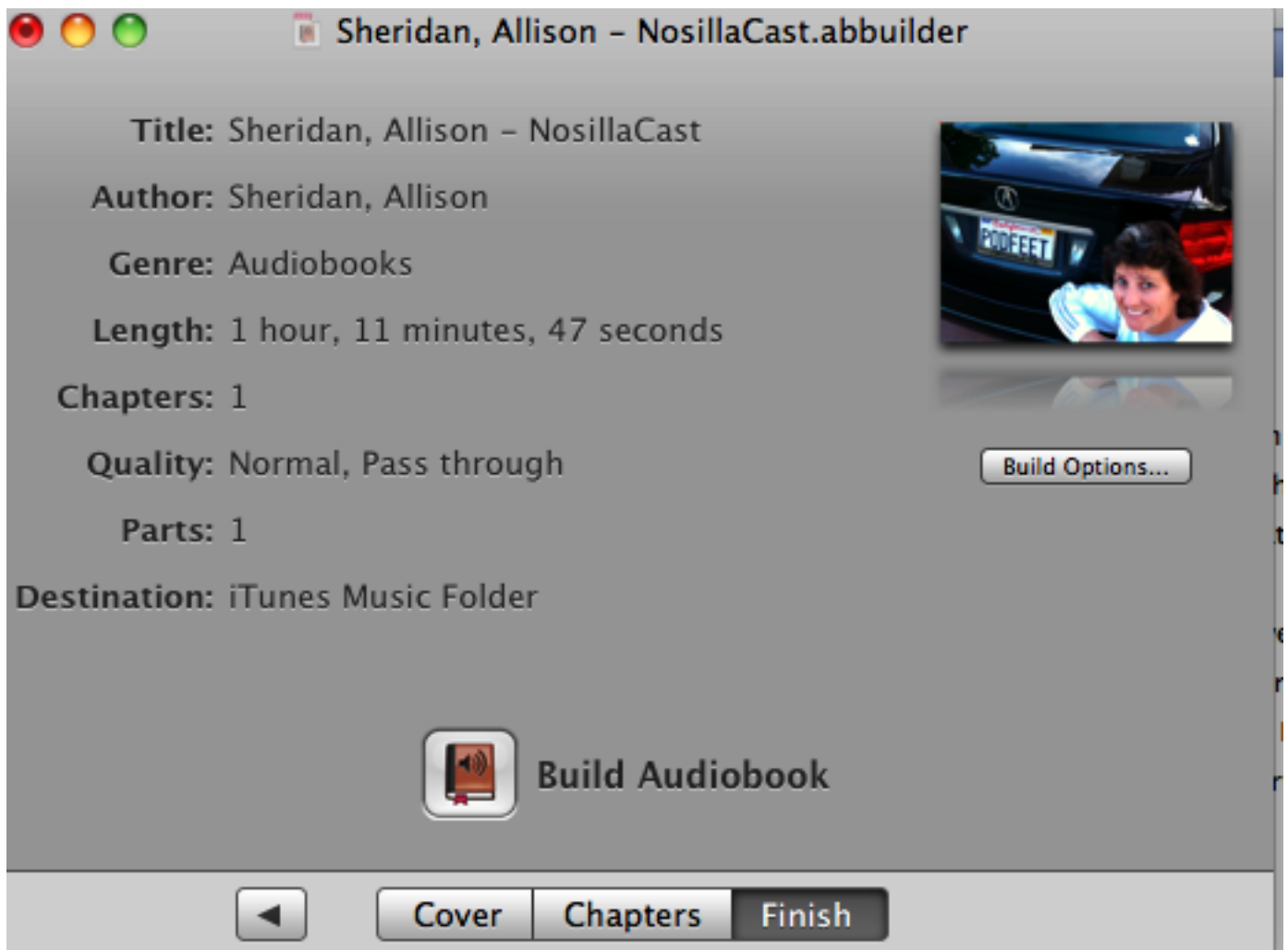


Imaginative!

Since this is an example, I am stopping with the import of 1 CD. Doing the next 9 is just doing repeating the import process

Being Finished, I click FINISH

13 - Here just click Build Audiobook

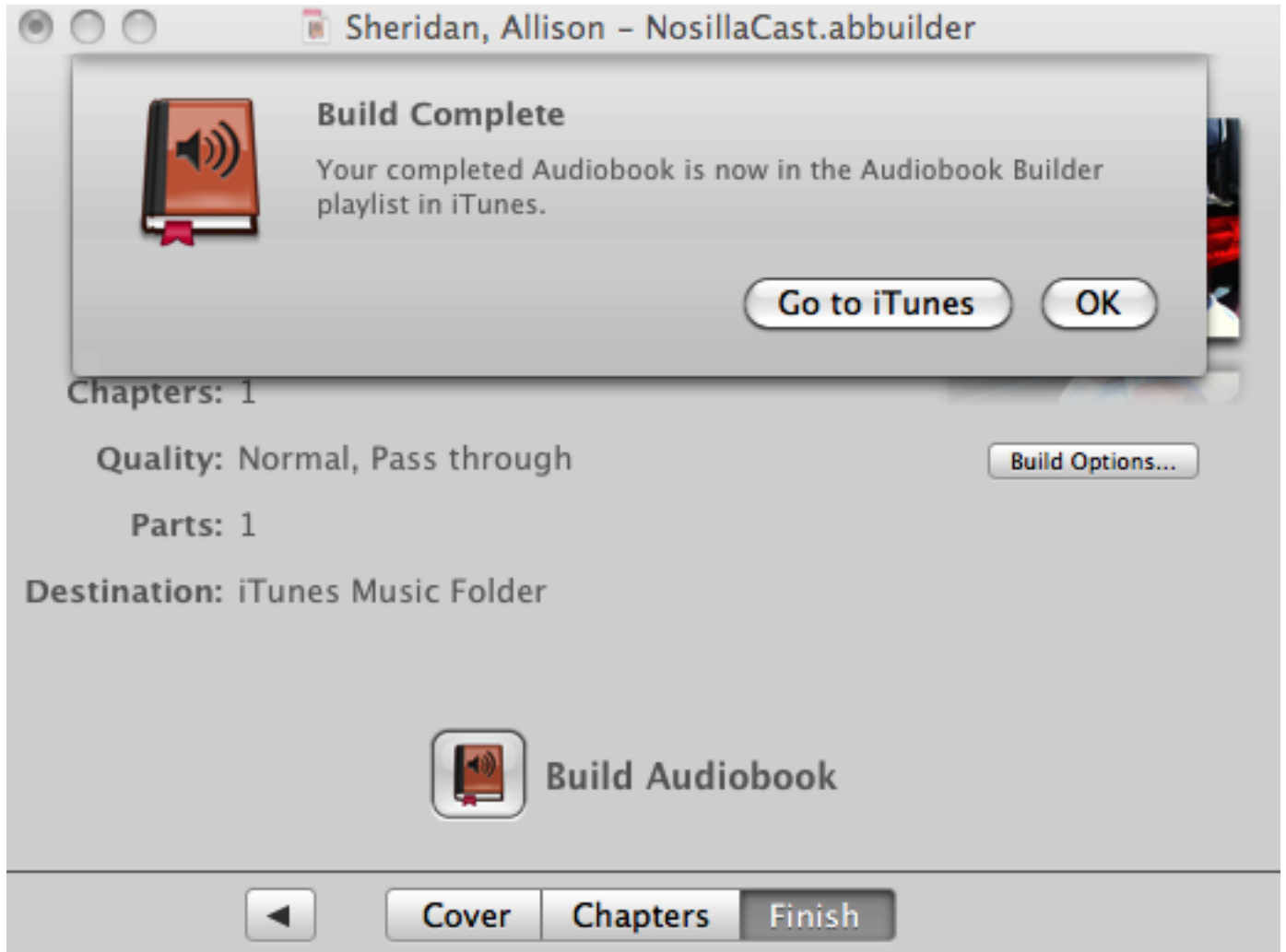


There are other options, if you click BUILD OPTIONS. I prefer to divide my audiobooks into separate parts, no more than five or six disks, where possible. In the past, ABB and Apple devices have had trouble with LONG audio books, which is why I divide mine up.

eg., Nosillacast 1 would have disks 1-5, Nosillacast 2, disks 6 - 10

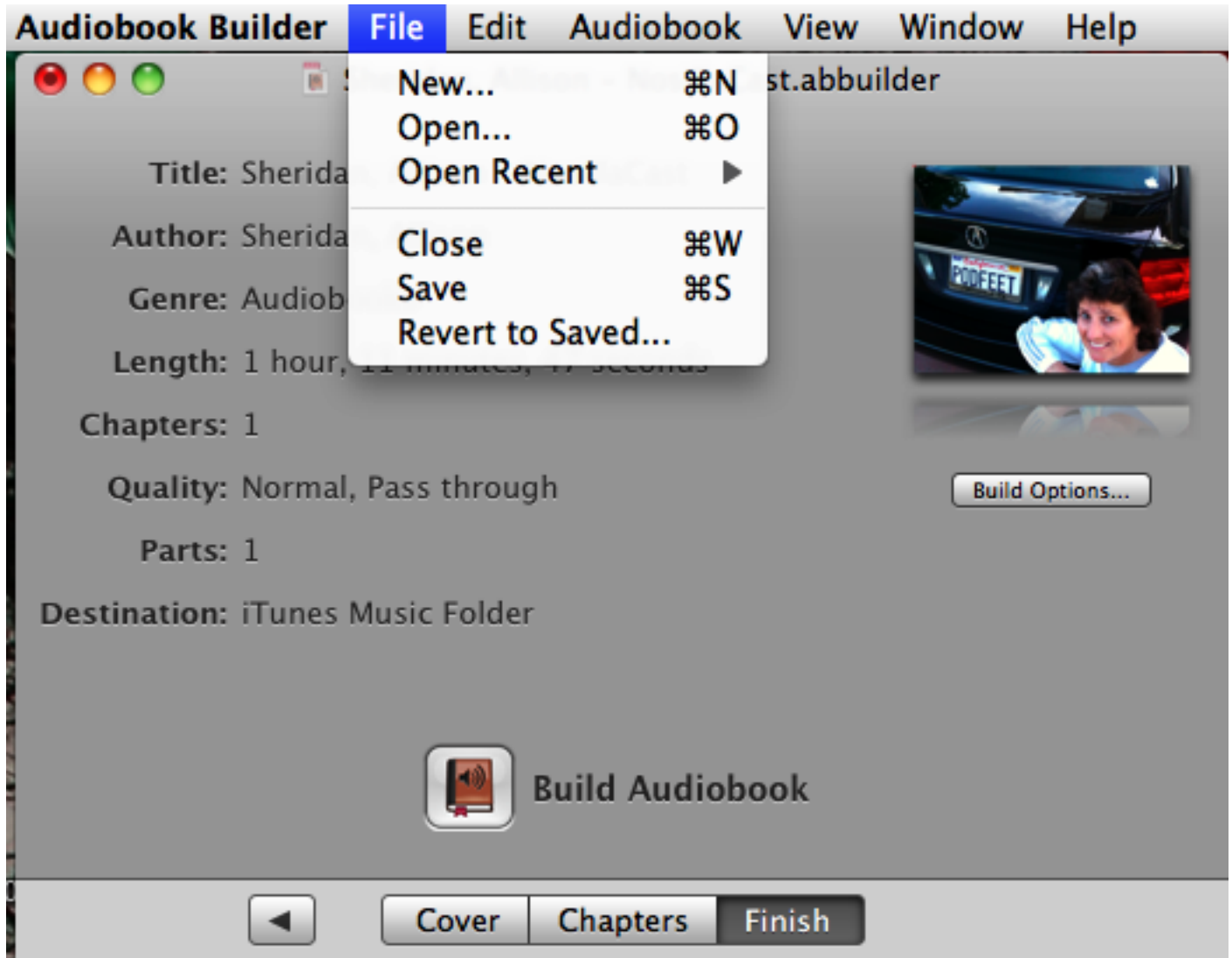
Name them right, and they will be together in iTunes and your iPod. When 1 finishes playing, your iPod will seamlessly move on to 2.

14 - Audiobook Builder builds your Audiobook and puts it in iTunes. Click go to iTunes, or OK

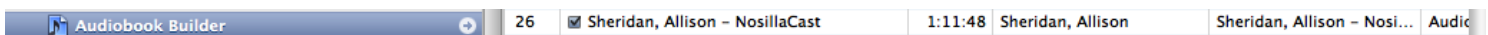


I'm clicking OK

15 - I save the Audiobook. If I wanted to import the next 9 CDs of Allison's Pulitzer Prize Winner, I could just reopen the same file

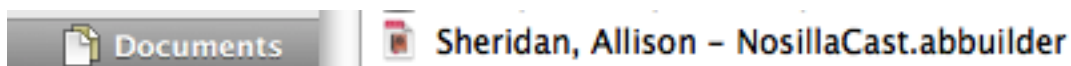


16 - Here's the new Audiobook in iTunes



Note: it is in an Audiobook Builder Folder, AND in the BOOKs folder at the top of the left column.

17 - I wait until I've finished listening to an audiobook, then delete the ABB file from my documents folder.



But I do keep the Audiobooks themselves for later replay --- after enough time has passed to forget the plot. For this, it is handy to have an extra USB harddrive for just audiobook back ups.
